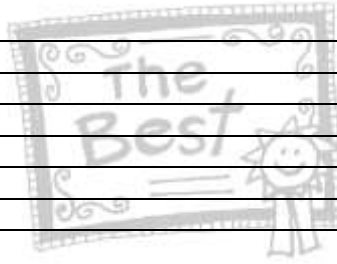
## Kind and Thoughtful Person
