Milk and Universal Free School Meals

A reminder that both milk and school meals are free to children in key stage 1. If you would like your child to have milk please inform the class teacher.

If your child is in KS2 and would like milk there is a cost of 14p per carton, payable daily at the kitchen when collecting the milk.

If your personal circumstances mean that you would be entitled to free school meals then please inform the office to ensure that the school can claim the correct pupil premium funding. The office will be able to tell you if you would be entitled.

Safety online reminder

Could parents please, please supervise children when using the internet at home either on the computer, mobile phone or any other electronic device that can access the internet. - Have family rules about how the internet will be used at home and be clear about what information is safe to share online
- Discuss rules about communicating online with friends
- Make sure you know what your children are doing online, much like you would in 'real' life and use parental controls (on computers, mobile phones and game consoles) to help you. Remember that these cannot always be 100% effective
- Make sure that your children are aware that people or websites can lie online
- Make sure your child understands that online actions can have offline consequences
