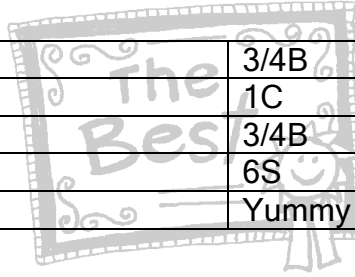
Kind and Thoughtful Person
