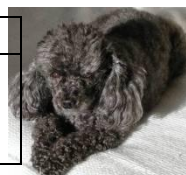
Kind and Thoughtful Person

School Dinners


