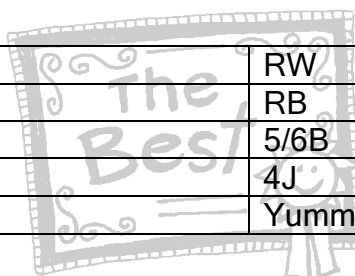
Celebration Assembly
