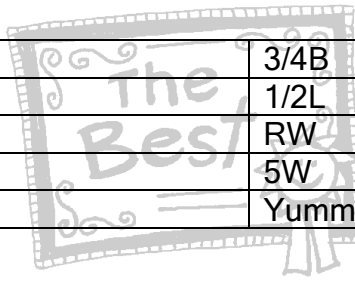
Celebration Assembly
