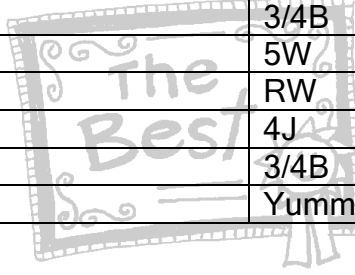
### Kind and Thoughtful Person
