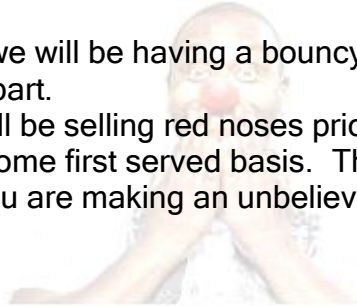
### Healthy Focus Week - Monday 14 March 2011 to Friday 18 March 2011
