## Are You Entitled to Free School Meals?

Parents/carers who are in receipt of benefit may be entitled to claim free school meals. You will qualify for free school meals if you or your partner are receiving:

- Income Support (IS);
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA);
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999; or
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are **not** entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income, as assessed by the Her Majesty's Revenue & Customs that does not exceed £16,190;
- An income-related employment and support allowance (irESA) (this benefit was introduced on 27 October 2008)
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.

If you are unsure as to whether you are entitled or not, come and speak to the office staff, bringing evidence of entitlement with you, who will be happy to help you.
