#### **Teachers' Strike Action**

A significant number of staff at St Mary's belong to the National Union of Teachers (NUT). They have informed me that they are going to take union action by going on strike on Wednesday 26 March 2014. The union has voted for this action to happen across the country. After consultation with the Governors, a decision has been made to close the following classes: RB, 1C, 1/2L, 3B and 6S. Staff do not take this decision lightly and will not be paid for that day. These staff feel pushed to the limit by certain Government decisions and feel that they are protecting an education service fit for purpose for both staff and children. I am sorry for the inconvenience this will cause to families. I do hope that I can count on your support. We have an amazing staff who always go the extra mile for the children and I hope that parents will understand the difficulties of this situation.

### School Dinners price increase from Monday 28 April 2014
