Safety online

I strongly recommend that parents/carers monitor their children's activity on the internet as it has come to my attention once again that children, some of them quite young, are using inappropriate sites at home. Some of the sites that our children are accessing at home are of an inappropriate adult nature! Could parents please, please supervise children when using the internet at home. We are doing everything that we can in school to ensure that our children are safe and constantly remind the children about e-safety. Following the tips listed below will help your child stay safe online.

- Have family rules about how the internet will be used at home and be clear about what information is safe to share online
- Discuss rules about communicating online with friends
- Make sure you know what your children are doing online, much like you would in 'real' life and use parental controls (on computers, mobile phones and game consoles) to help you. Remember that these cannot always be 100% effective
- Make sure that your children are aware that people or websites can lie online
- Make sure you child understands that online actions can have offline consequences
