- Make sure your child understands that online actions can have offline consequences

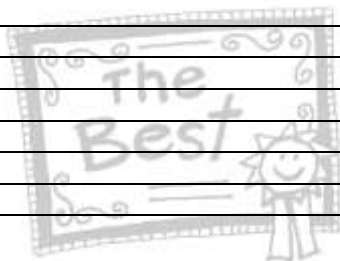
